Mr. Orestes also explained the viceroy system of government implemented by the Spanish ‘conquistadores’ when they overthrew the Incan empire--Peru proclaimed its independence from Spain on July 28th, 1821.

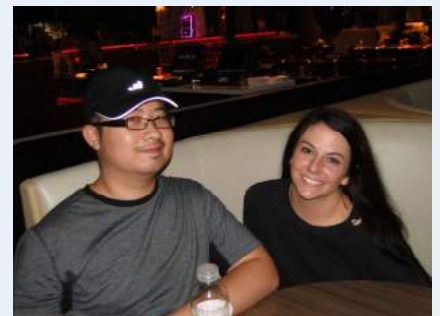


JUNE 2018 SIDEWALK SALE
